Objective and investment policy

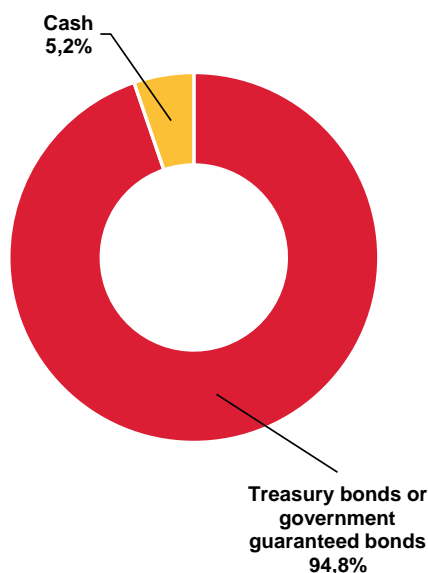
IS Non-Index Fund is an Alternative Investment Fund for Retail Investors (AIF for retail) that invests in non-indexed government bonds and non-indexed deposits. The Fund may invest up to 100% in non-indexed government-guaranteed bonds. The Fund may also invest up to 20% in bank deposits and up to 10% in derivatives to reduce risk.

The Funds investment authorizations are based on Act no. 45/2020.

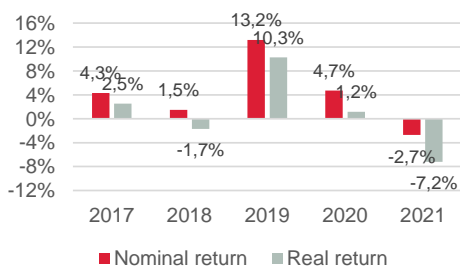

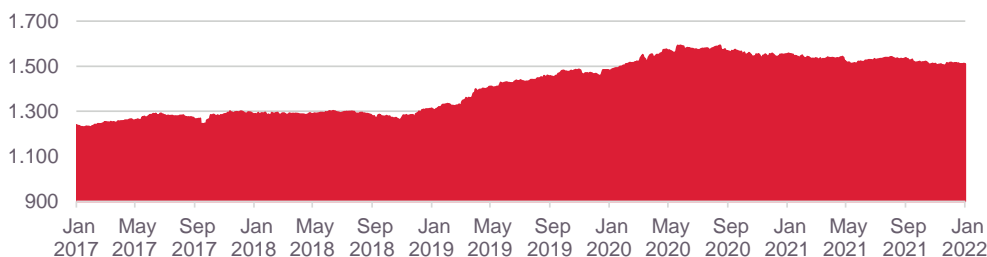

Íslandssjóðir's risk management conducts regular stress tests for Íslandssjóðir's alternative investment funds. Stress tests assess the impact of different scenarios on funds' portfolios under normal and exceptional liquidity conditions.

The risk and reward indicator demonstrates where the Fund ranks in terms of its potential risk and reward. The higher the rank the greater the potential reward but the greater the risk of losing money. It is based on past data, may change over time and may not be a reliable indication of the future risk profile of the Fund. Risk factors that affect the value of a holding in the fund but the risk indicator does not cover are credit risk, liquidity risk, counterparty risk and operational risk.

Risk management monitors the funds' investment on a daily basis and whether investments are within risk limits. If a fund exceeds limits, e.g. due to market conditions or flow in or out of the fund, the fund manager is notified without delay and appropriate measures are taken. In the event of a violation of law requirements, it is reported to the Financial Supervisory Authority.

Various financial risks are always related to investment activities, such as the risk of no yield or the risk of losing the capital invested. The price and return of the Fund reflects market fluctuations, if interest rates rise, bonds at a fixed income rate drop in value and bonds with long maturities drop more than short-term bonds, based on the same changes in yield.
